**Step 1:** Log into Studentaid.gov using your FSA ID and password. Once you log in you should arrive on your main dashboard.

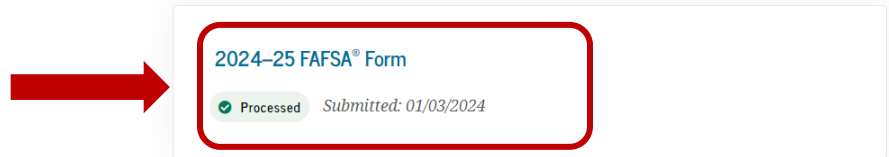
**Step 2:** Once your on your dashboard, scroll down to the **My Activity**. Here you should see your 2024-25 FAFSA form. Click on **View All Activity**.



**Step 3:** On the My Activity page you will see your open applications. Click on **your 2024-25 FAFSA** form to open it.

**Step 4:** Scroll down on the Status Tracker. Under FAFSA Form Processed you'll see an option to open your FAFSA Submission Summary.

**Step 5:** Now your FAFSA Submission Summary should be open. Click on the **Print FAFSA Submission Summary** on the top and then Save as PDF. That should enable you to save it on your computer to then attach it to your application. You can also print the file, scan it, and then attach it to your application.


The file should be around 16 pages. If it is not, you most likely do not have your full Submission Summary.
