How to retrieve your FAFSA Submission Summary from FAFSA



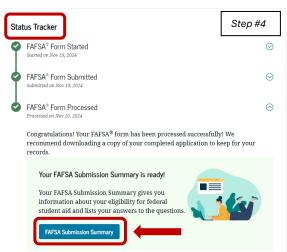
Step 1: Log into Studentaid.gov using your FSA ID and password. Once you log in you should arrive on your main dashboard.

Step 2: Once you're on your dashboard, go to the *My Info* section on the right-hand side, and then click on *My Activity*.



Step 3: On the My Activity page you will see your currently active applications. Click on **your 2025-26 FAFSA** form to open it.





Step 4: Scroll down on the Status Tracker. Under FAFSA Form Processed you'll see an option to open your FAFSA Submission Summary.

Step 5: Now your FAFSA Submission Summary should be open. Click on the *Print FAFSA Submission Summary* on the

top and then Save or Print as PDF. That should enable you to save it on your computer to then attach it to your application. You can also print the file, scan it, and then attach it to your application.

The file should be around 10-20 pages. If it is not, you most likely do not have your full Submission Summary. We need the complete file for this requirement to be satisfied.
